Sunflowers

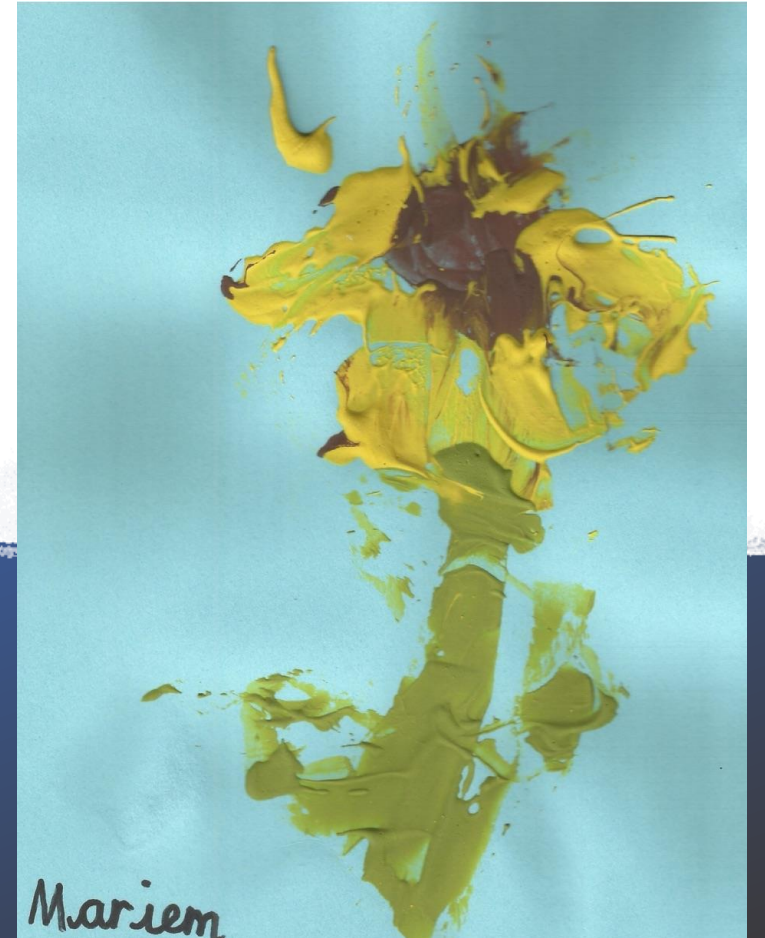
The children looked at some sunflowers. We discussed colours and shapes before they tried to draw or paint them using oil pastels or very thick paint which was applied with a glue spreader.



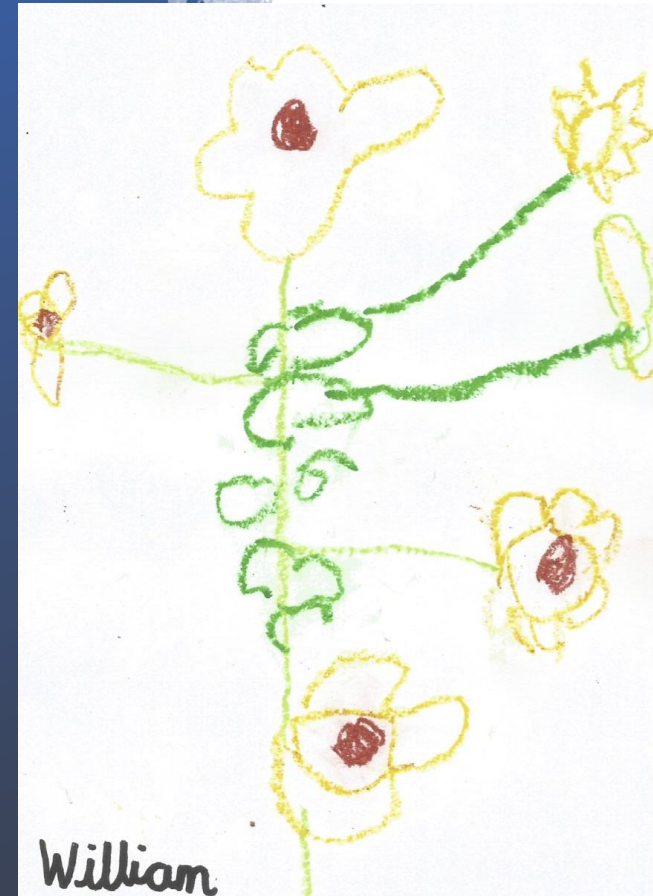
