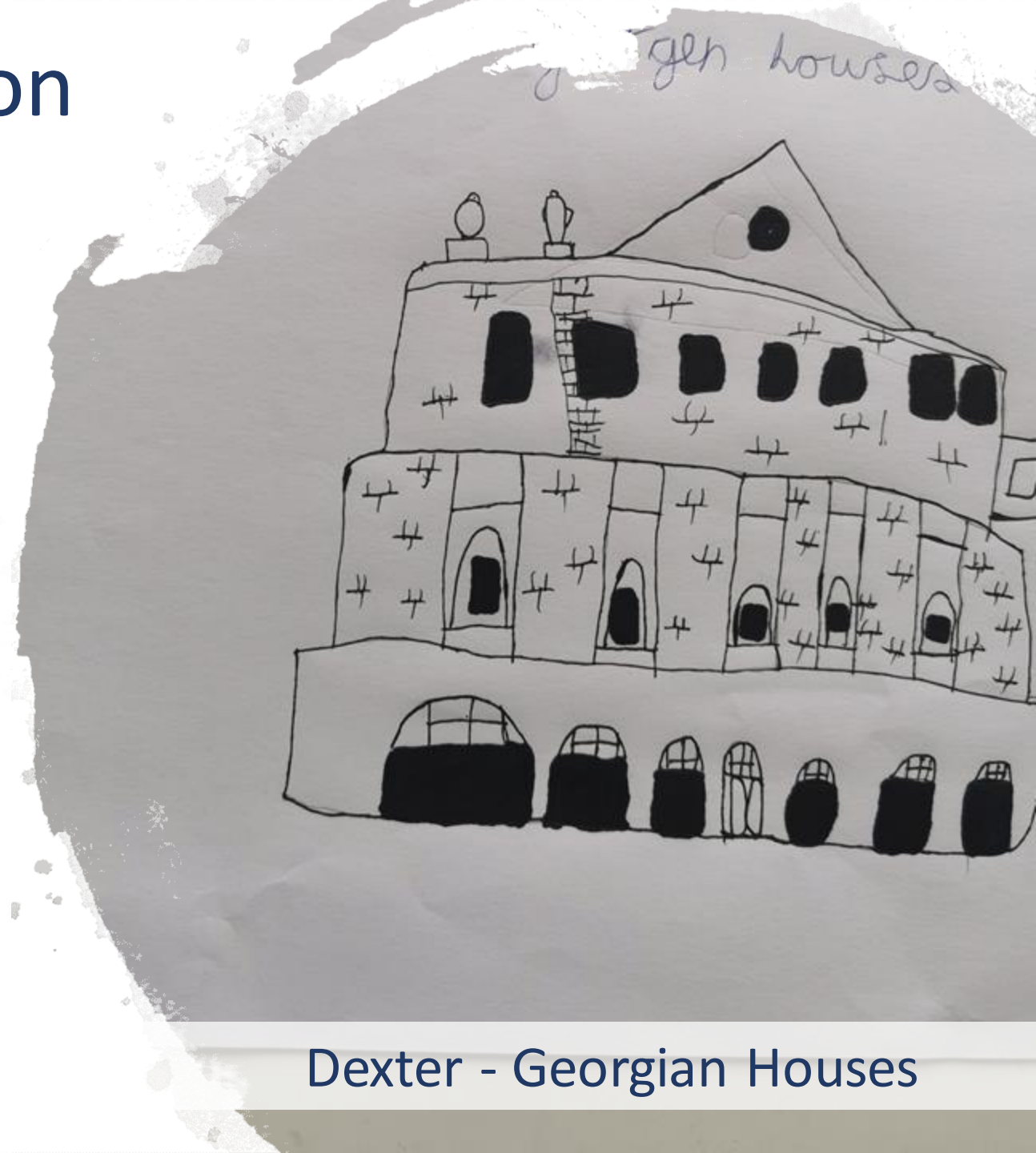


A Note from Miss Johnston

We took time focusing on the Georgians and the transformation between and now.



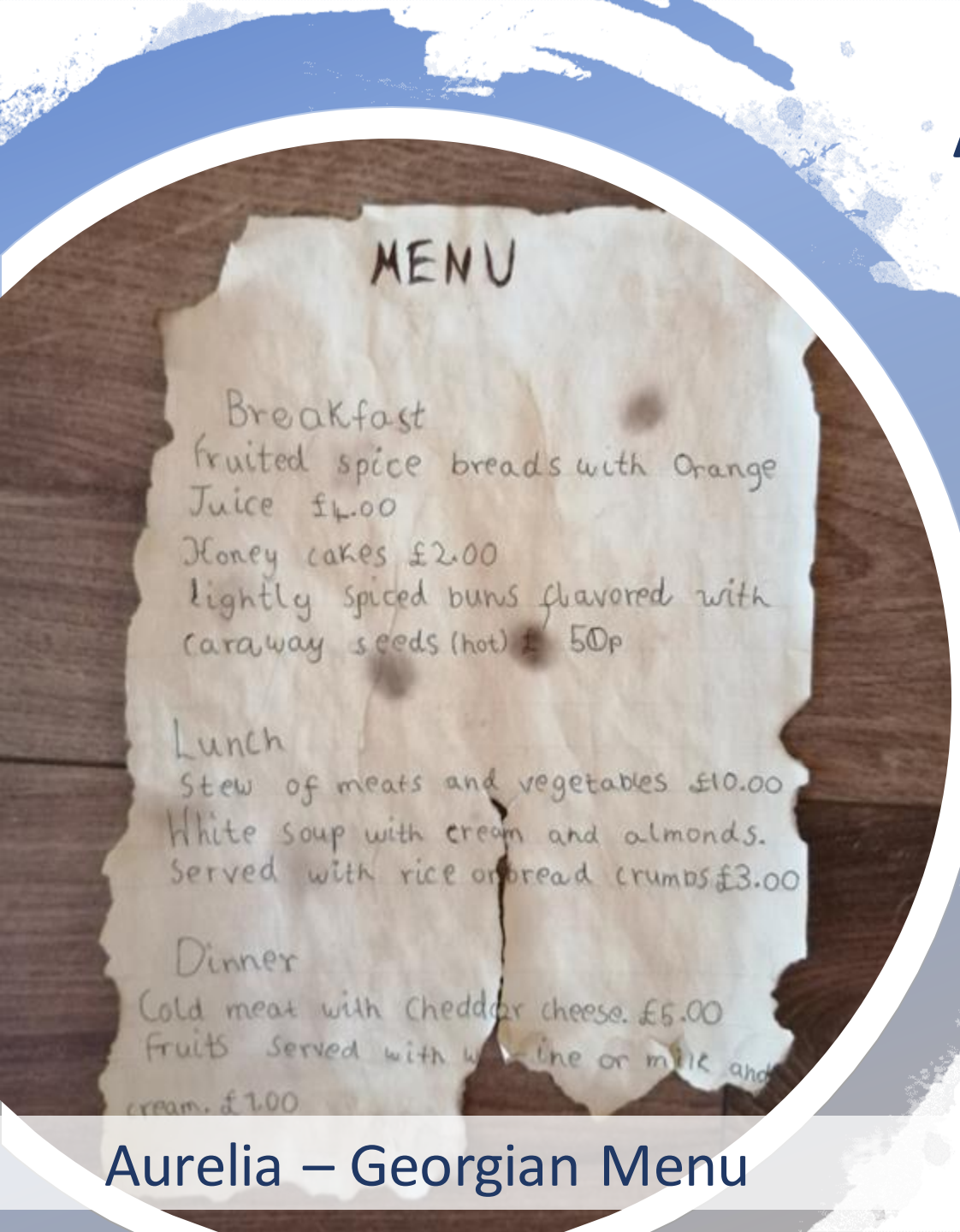

I am so proud of you all!

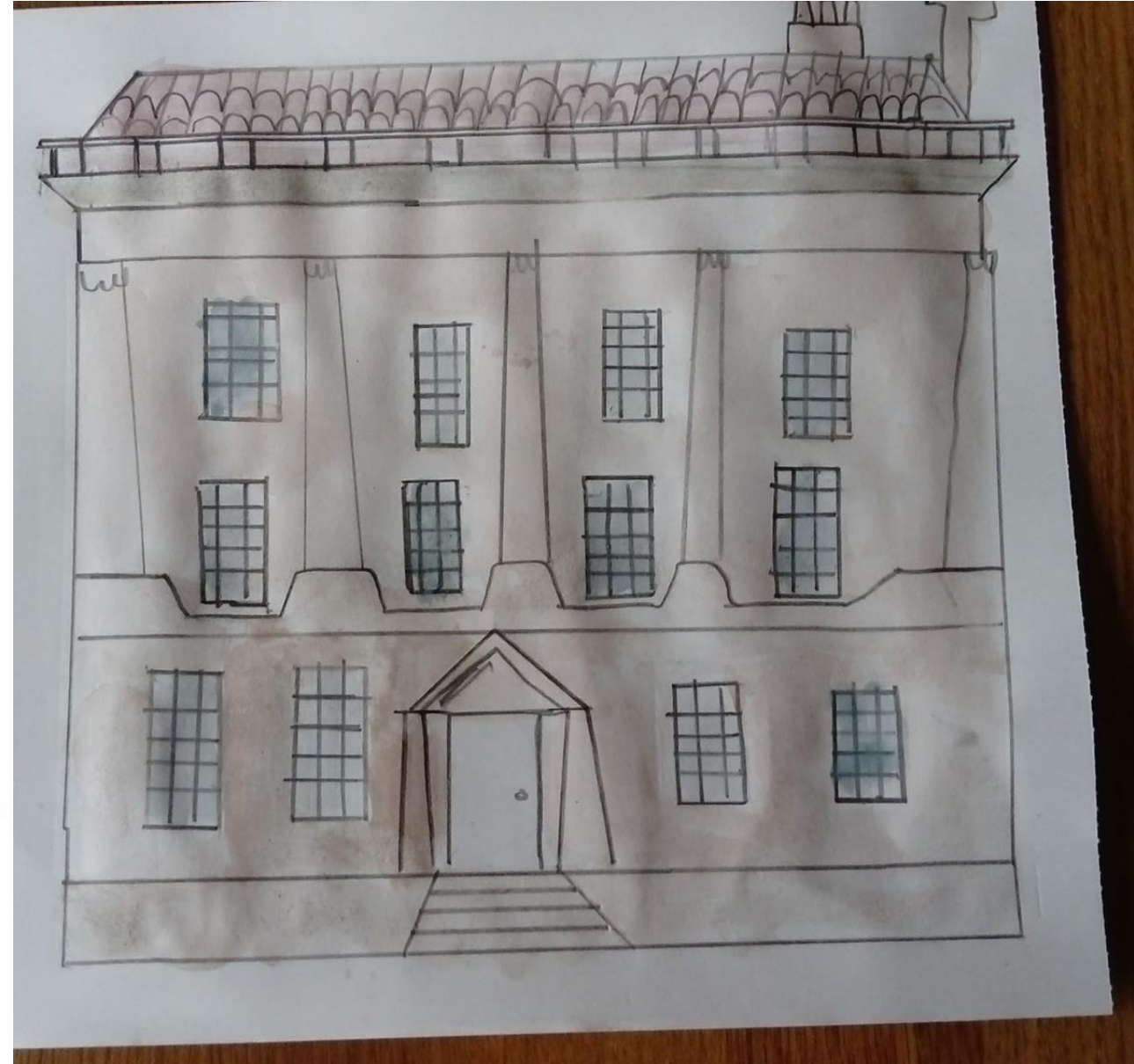

THE GEORGIAN ERA

From 1714 to c.1830-37



Named after the Hanoverian Kings George

GEORGE I

Was king of Great Britain and Ireland. He was the first British monarch of the house of Hanover.

GEORGE II

He is the most recent British monarch born outside of Great Britain. He was born in Germany.

GEORGE III

He was the sixth king of the United Kingdom.

GEORGE IV

He was an outstanding and elegant art collector and builder.

MY SILHETTE

In the Georgian era portraits were expensive, however, there was another way to create a picture of yourself and these were called silhouettes.

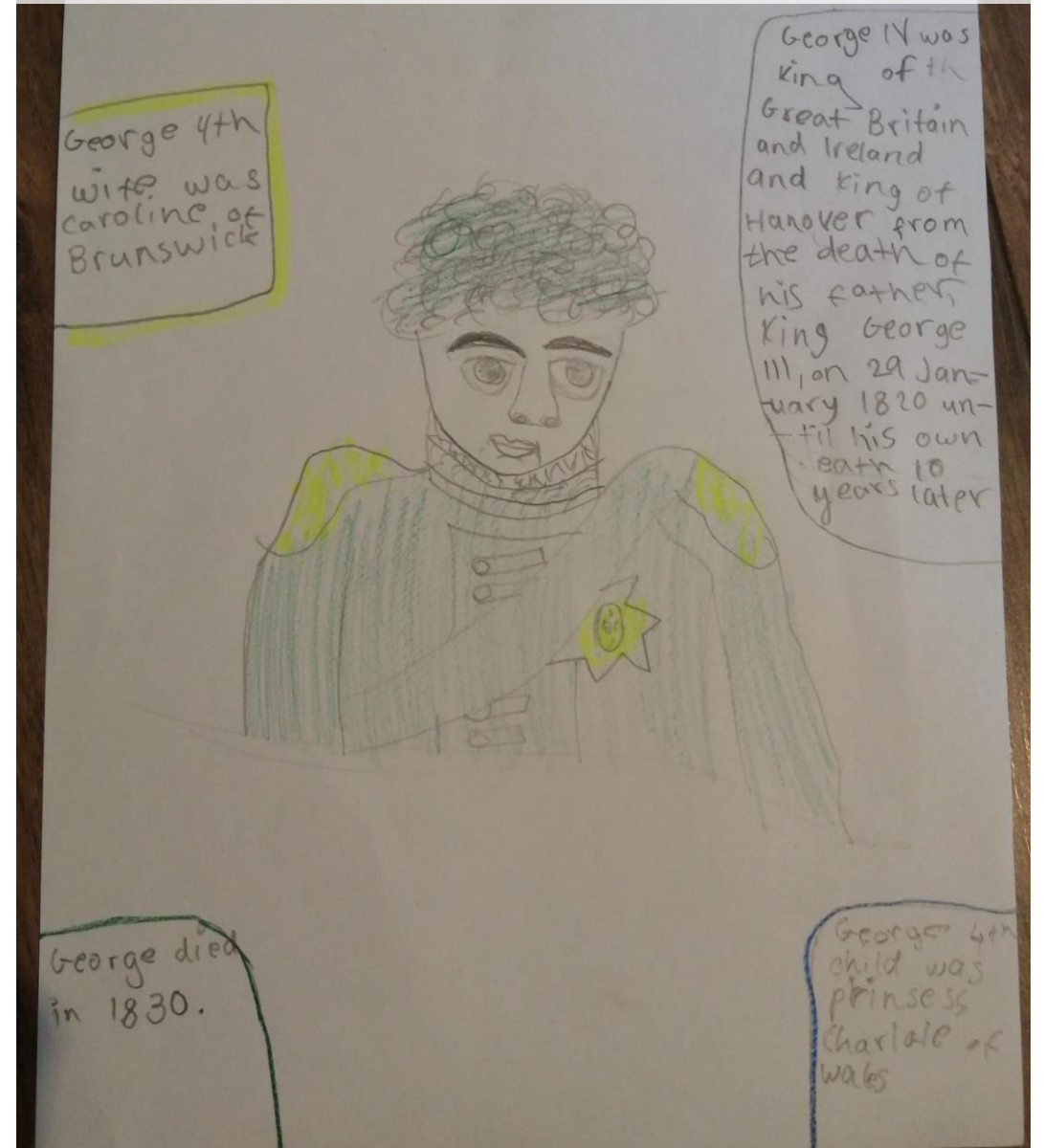
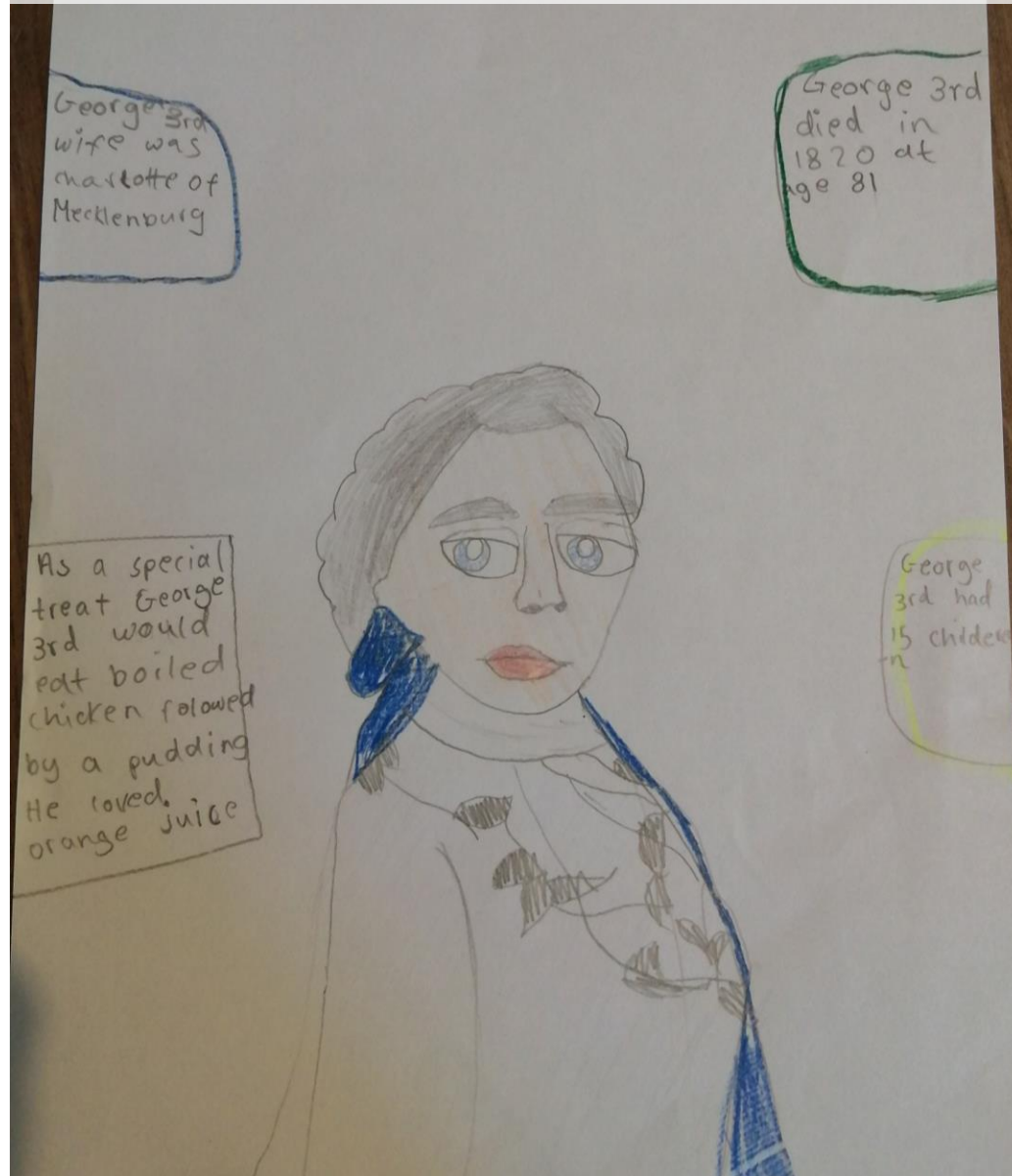

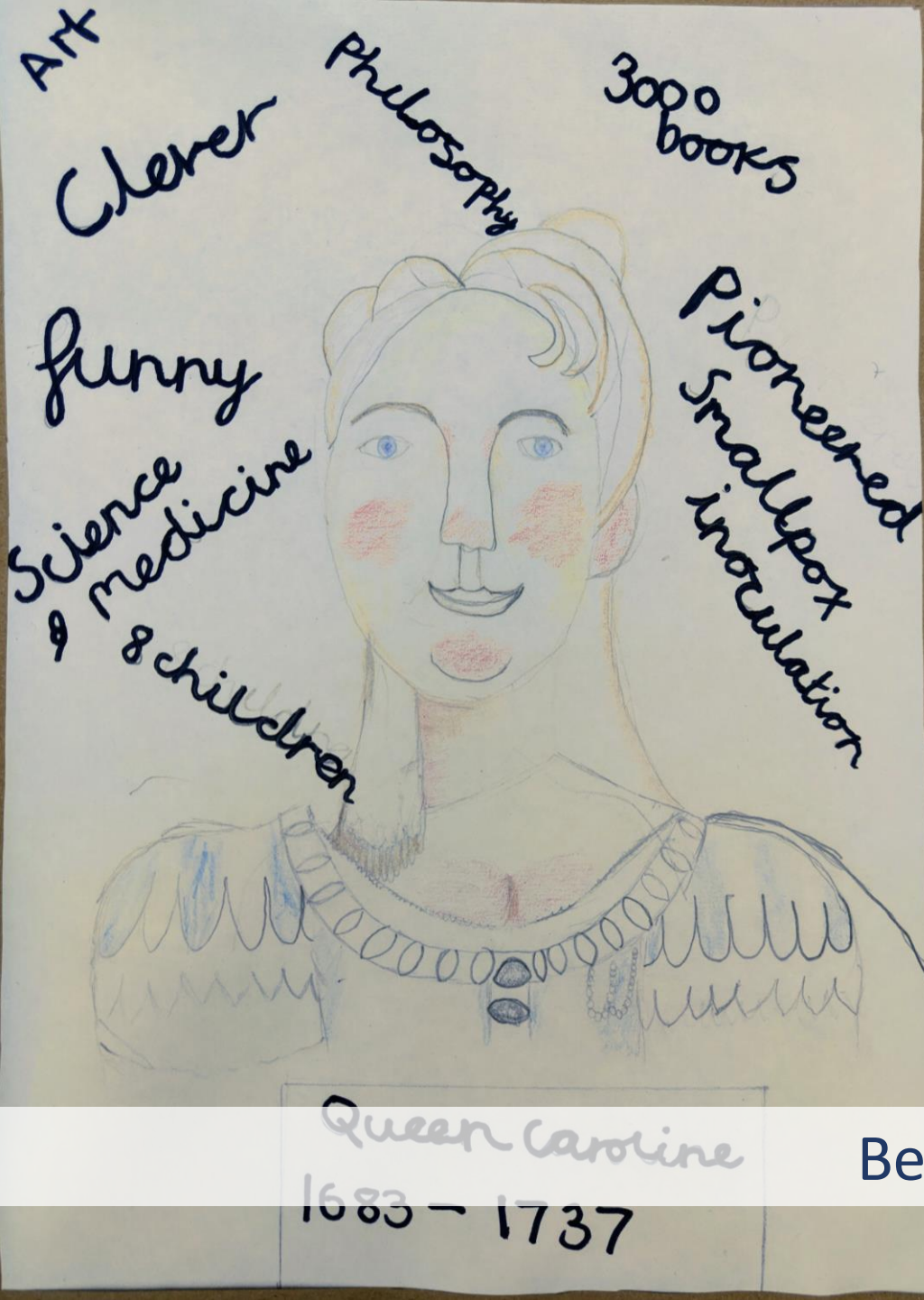

the royal residence.

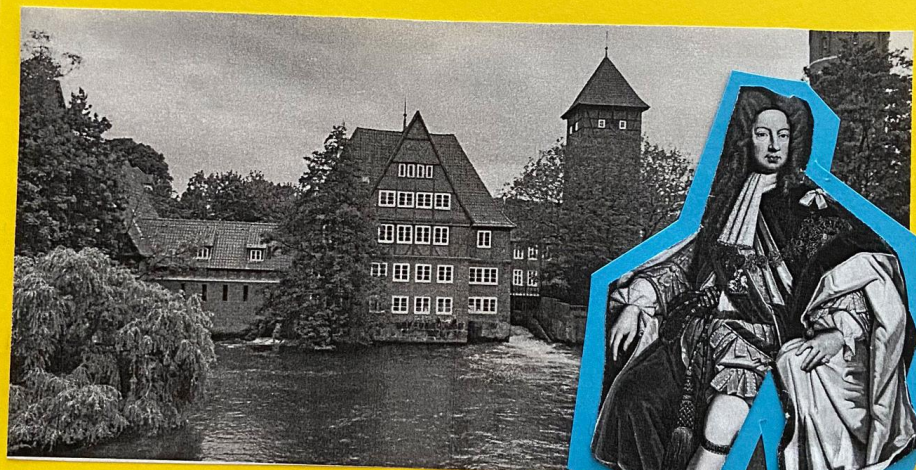
He was succeeded

October 11, 1727.

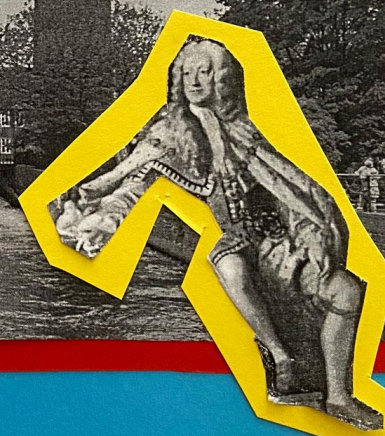
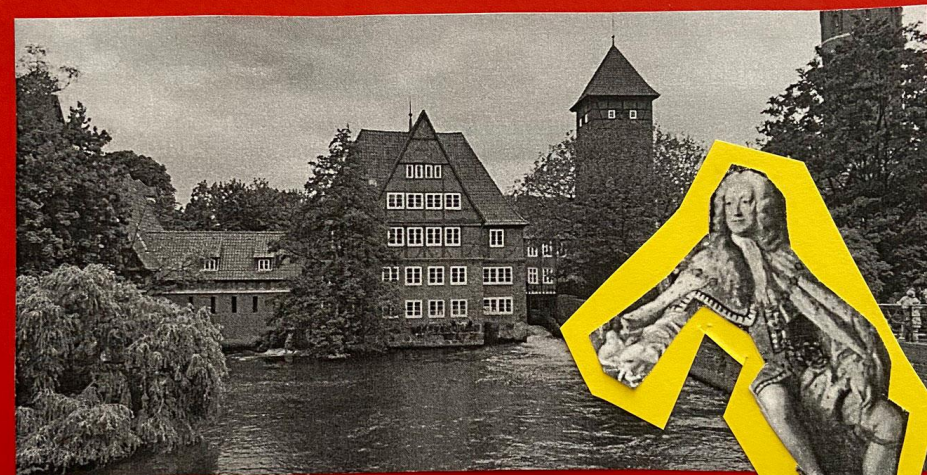

He was crazy

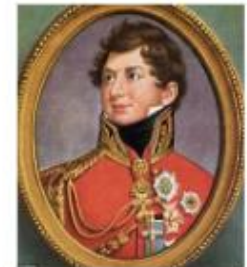


GEORGE IV

He tried to divorce her



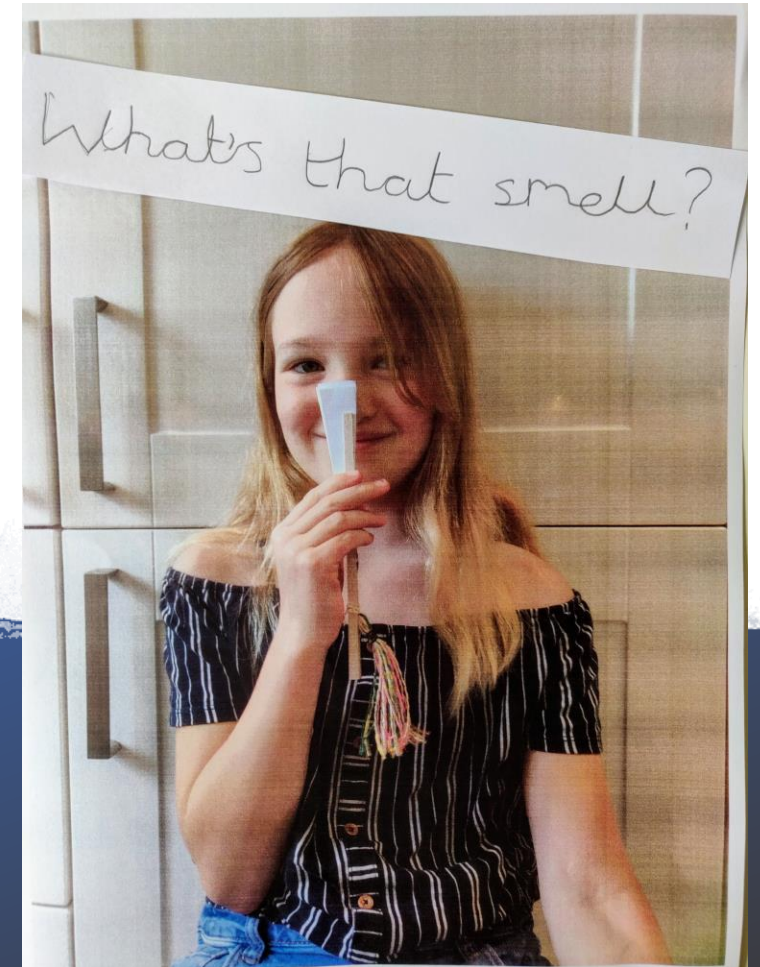
