### Leave of absence in term time - what it means for you and your child

Our School Policy is that no holidays will be authorised in term time. If a parent decides to take their child out of school without authorisation, this may result in a Penalty Notice fine being issued by the Local Authority.

The fine applies to all parents and carers. We strongly encourage families to take holiday during school holidays.

Absence requests will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. This request must be put in writing to the Head Teacher, at least 2 weeks before, fully explaining the reason for the request.

The Head Teacher will consider each request carefully and will look at the child's attendance over the last 12 months. Permission for absence will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, when the reason for the request is very clear. Birthdays, anniversaries and other family events will not be considered as exceptional circumstances.
